

Covid Protocol - Updated January 2022

Seating- based on current attendance at the regular weekend services, worshippers can sit where they're comfortable. Most people will sit near someone they are comfortable with, but can also still socially distance.

Masks-encouraged but not required, worshippers should do what they feel comfortable with. Elders/communion assistant and pastor will wear them for communion distribution.

Communion distribution- will change to a continuous format one side at a time with a single file line down the center aisle. Elder/communion assistant and pastor will serve anyone needing communion at their seat first, then do the lectern side and move to the pulpit side. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes are available in the narthex and elevator room area. Different from sitting in the pews, sometimes a person can't chose who they kneel next to at the railing. Elder/communion assistant and pastor will continue sanitizing their hands before communion distribution.

Offering- continue as it's been done over past few months

Handshakes and hugs- Put on hold for time being

If you're sick...stay home and worship with us through the St. Paul's YouTube channel or radio broadcast. Saturday evening worship is live streamed through YouTube and saved for six months.
